Getting there:

Directions:

Loafer Creek Swim area is about 10 minutes from the Bidwell Marina. As you head out of the marina through the adjacent houseboat village, head towards the south shoreline on your right. Kayaks and dinks can be launched from shore at the marina, or at the Bidwell Marina launch ramp which is where day sailors would need to launch. This is a bit further away by about 10 minutes. We can probably tow boats back to the launch sites at the conclusion of the raft up party as long as the skippers are willing and can get the hook up!

Brunch Suggestions:

Casseroles like quiche, egg dishes, fruit, croissants, bagels, muffins, sausage, jams, butter, cream cheese, etc.

Beverages such as Champaign, Bloody Mary's, Gin Fizzes, Irish Coffee, juice, coffee, tea, Pepto Bismo, etc.

Karen and I are both open to input and suggestions. If other boats are coming and can carry a few passengers, let Herb know so he can help coordinate rides if need be.

If we have too large a response to this invitation, we might regroup and have a dock party at the marina under the patio. I'll need to get permission first.
